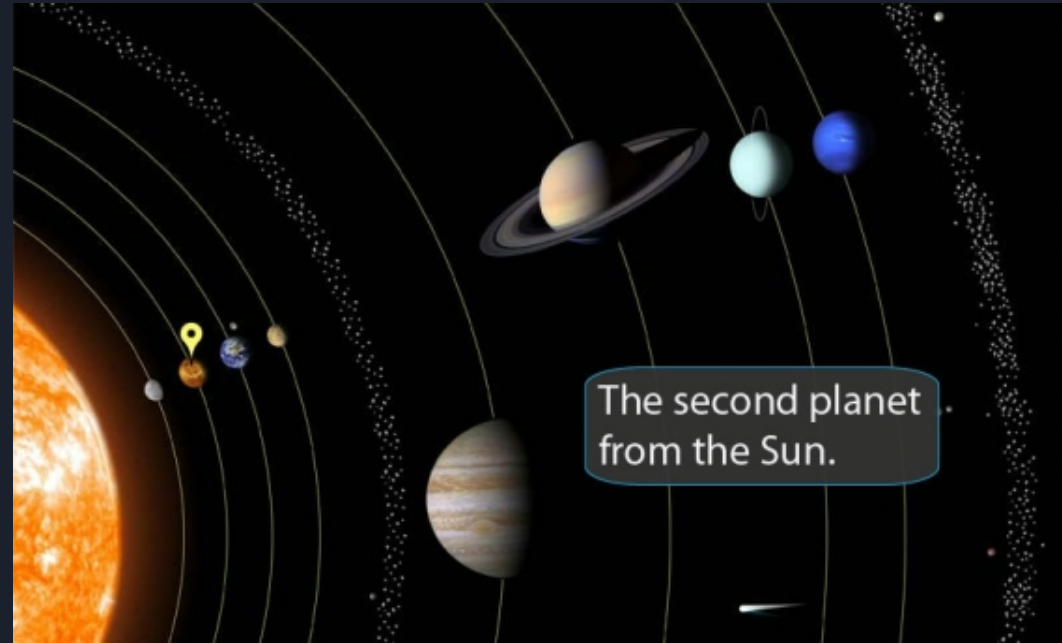
# What was Venus named after

Venus is the second planet closest from the sun which means it is an inner planet. an inner planet is a planet whose orbit lies within the asteroid belt.



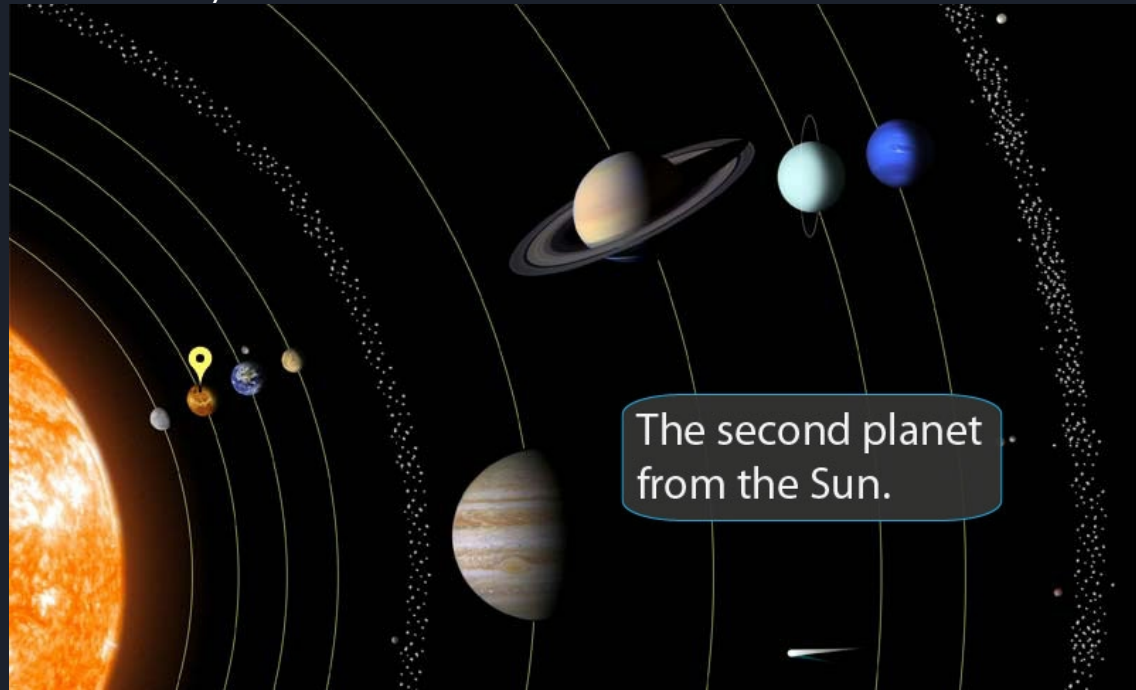
# Is it an inner or an outer planet?

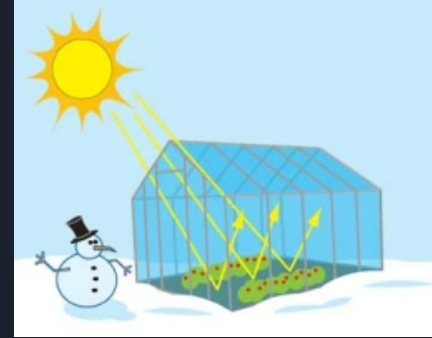
# How far is Venus from the sun exactly?

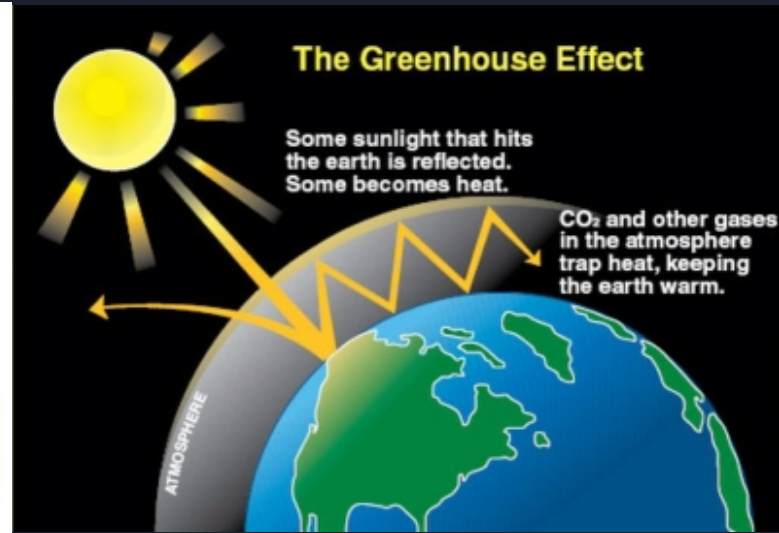
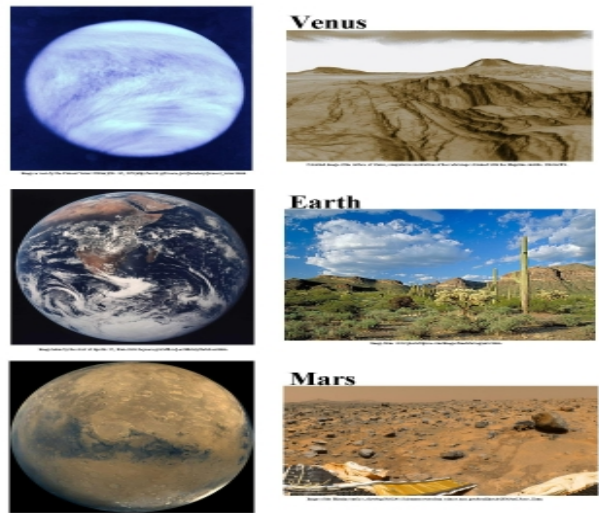

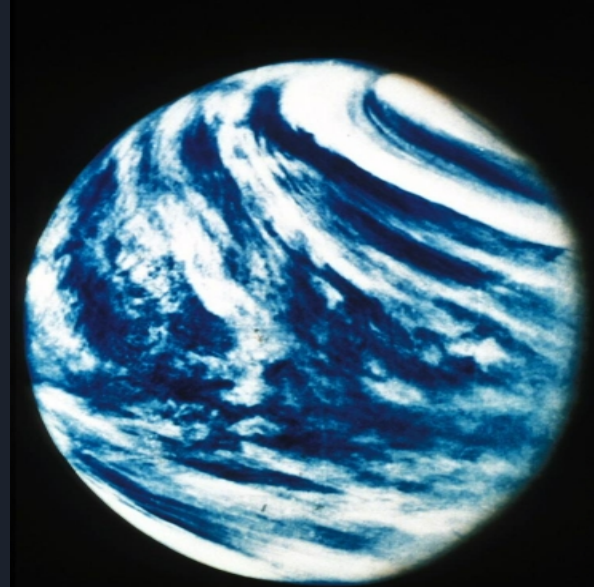
# Dose it have moons?

No Venus have no moons if it did this slide would have been longer but nope. No moons.



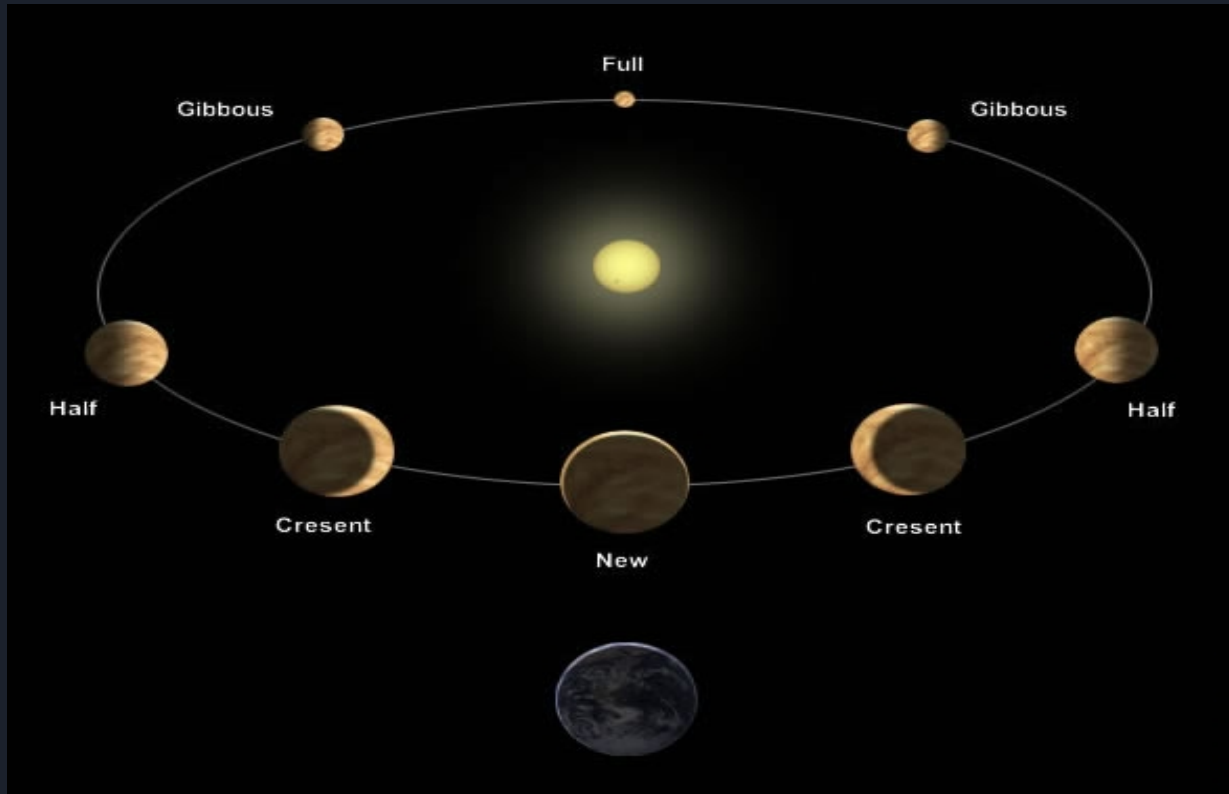
# Does Venus have rings?
