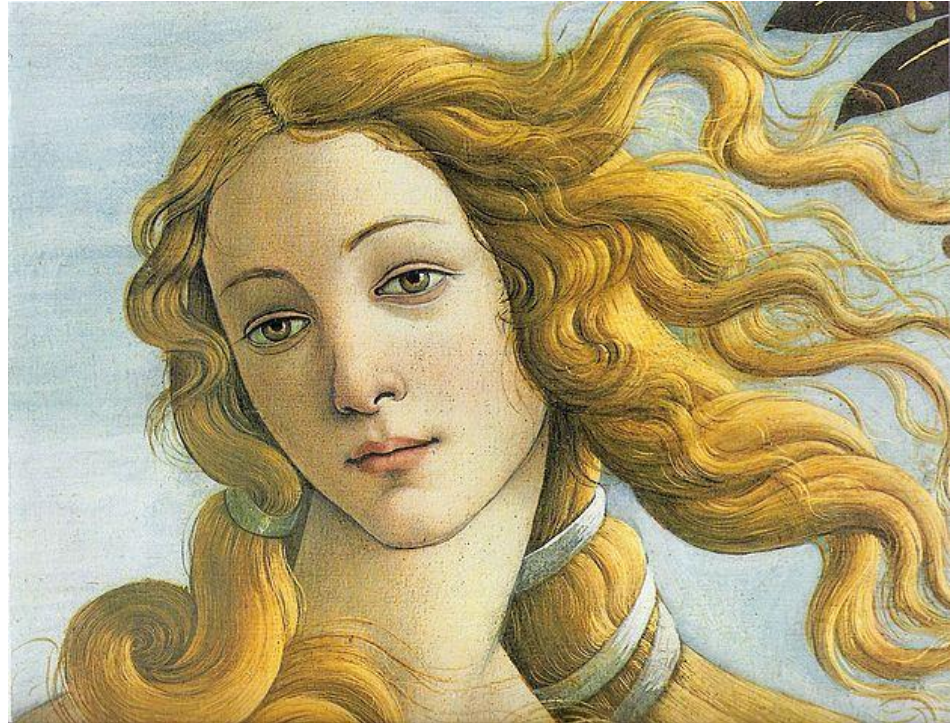

# WHAT AND WHO VENUS WAS NAMED AFTER

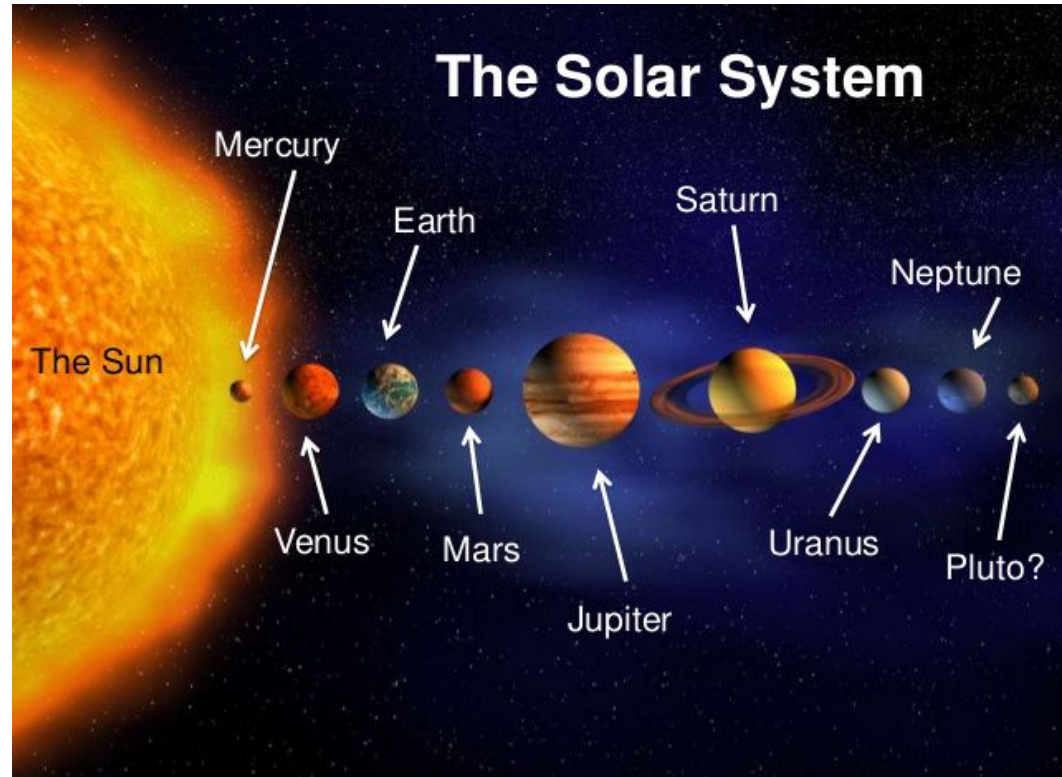
Venus was named after the love and beauty goddess. Venus is the only planet named after a goddess in our solar system.

# LOCATION OF VENUS

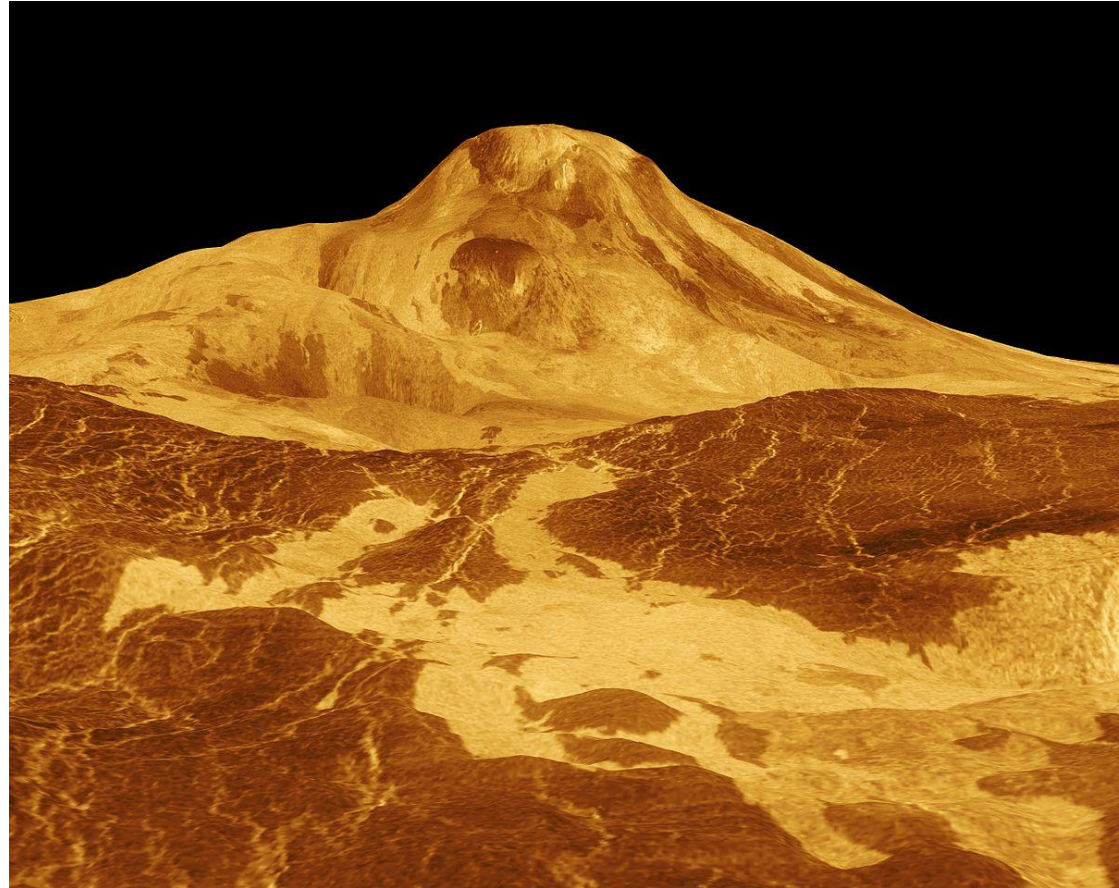
